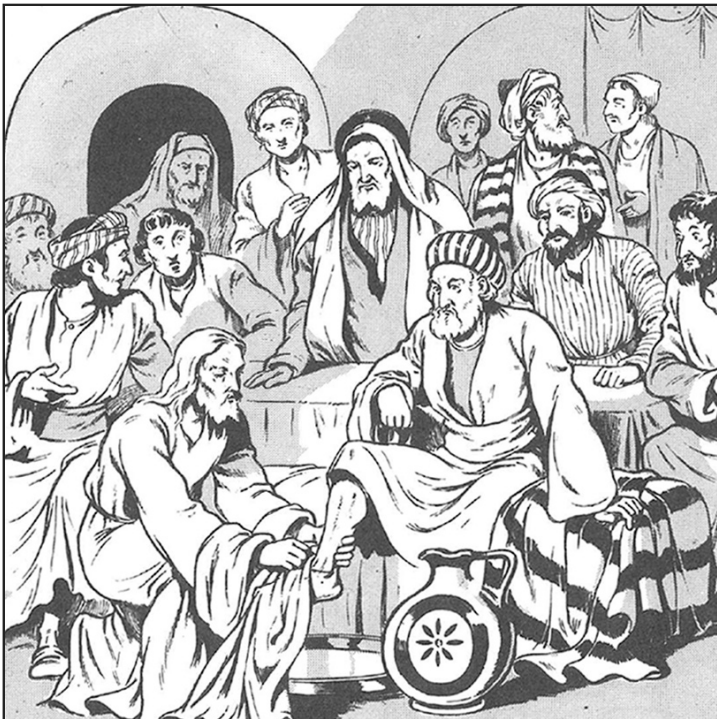




**The owner of the donkeys,

willingly lends his animals.**



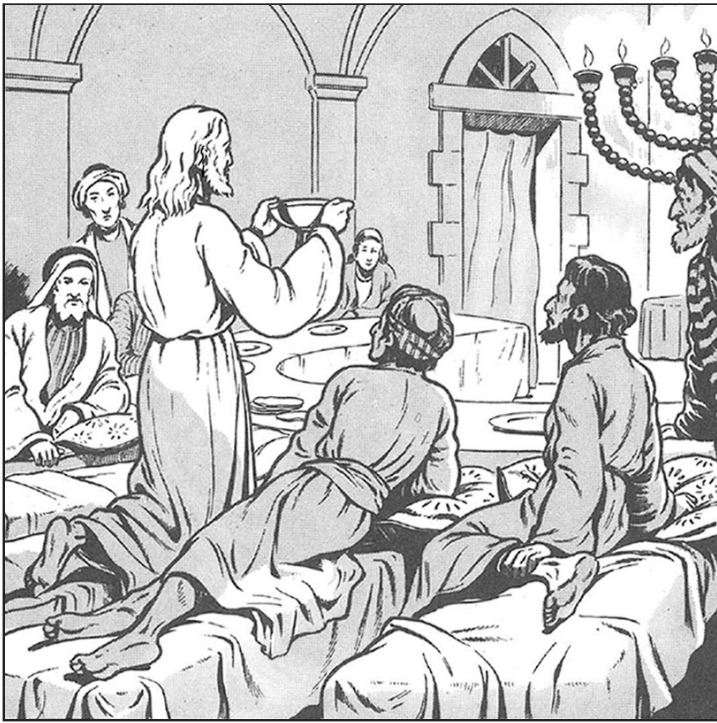
**The children run around

shed for the forgiveness of your sins."**



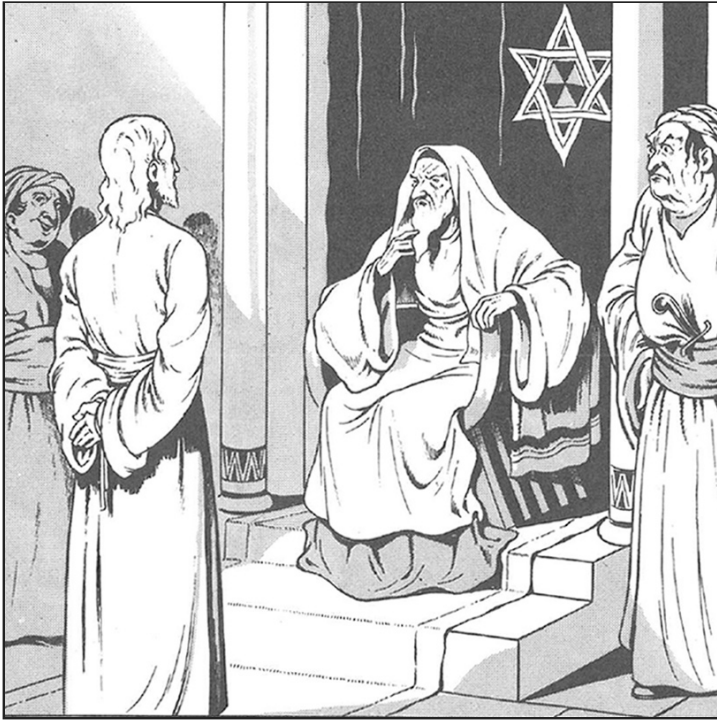
**In the garden of Gethsemane,

When Jesus is dragged into the presence of the old and cruel high priest Anne, he rejoices wickedly to see Him chained.



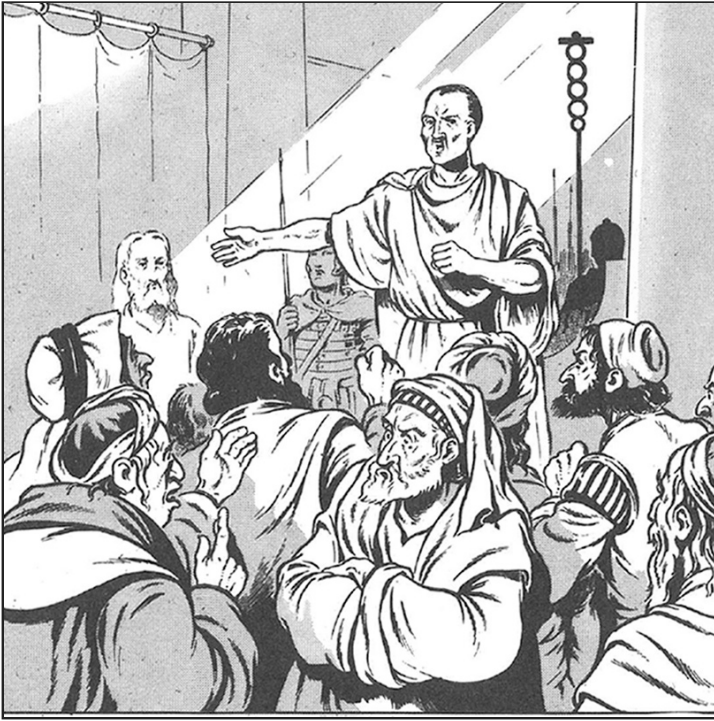
Jesus is dragged from one court to another. The executioners and the crowd abuse Him and shout insults and death threats at Him.

Jesus is crowned with thorns. The long thorns pierce into His skull and out through His eyes. It is an atrocious torture.



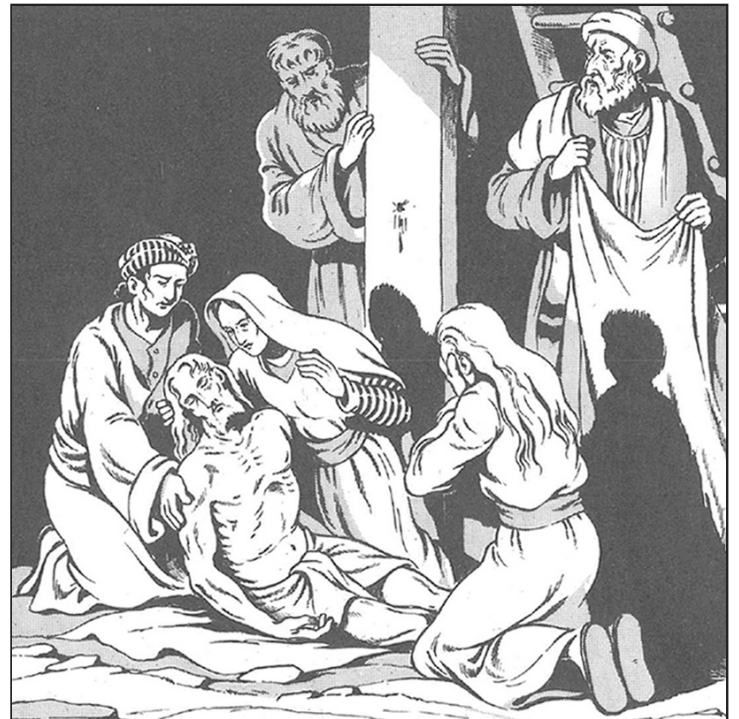
**With His body all torn up,
